Admissions Transfer Policy

Students who are currently enrolled in a PharmD program at another institution are welcome to apply to the Bernard J. Dunn School of Pharmacy (BJDSOP). However, due to the differences in curricula between institutions, students admitted to BJDSOP will begin in year one and no credits from the previous institution will be accepted. To apply as a transfer student the following documentation must be received by the BJDSOP admissions office (transfer students do not apply through PharmCAS) by June 1 of the year of matriculation:

- Letter of support from the Dean, Office of Academic Affairs, or Office of Student Affairs from their prior institution
- Personal statement indicating applicant's intentions to continue education at Shenandoah University
- PCAT scores no more than 5 years old
- Official transcripts from applicant's pharmacy school and undergraduate institutions
- Letters of recommendation (3) with at least one from a current faculty member
- Resume/CV
