

Application Information for International Students

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Official Course-By-Course Evaluation**
 - Any non-U.S. transcript must be course-by-course evaluated by an NACES accredited agency. An English translation will not be accepted. You can use any provider listed at www.naces.org. All associated fees are the responsibility of the applicant.
 - WES ICAP package is recommended: Official Transcripts will be sent to Shenandoah University by WES at a minimal, additional cost.
 - For graduate applicants: some programs allow for unofficial NACES evaluation submission in place of a transcript for initial admission.

- **Official Transcript(s)**
 - From all institutions of higher education attended where credit was earned (even if an evaluation was completed).
 - Some graduate applicants can submit unofficial transcript(s) for initial admission. A copy of NACES evaluation can be uploaded but official copies of transcript and evaluation will be required if accepted.

- **Language Proficiency** can be met by one of the below:
 - Completion of at least 48 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 in a post-secondary institution where English is the language of instruction
 - Minimum TOEFL score of 79 or IELTS score of 6.5*
 - 450 or higher on SAT critical reading section or 19 or higher on ACT

*School of Health Professions and Nursing require 83 or higher on TOEFL and do not accept IELTS.
