PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Graduate Certificate in Healthcare Management from the Harry F. Byrd, Jr. School of Business at Shenandoah University offers a concise, flexible program that will allow you to understand the dynamics and complexities of the healthcare industry and to deliver impactful results.

Healthcare employment opportunities are growing faster than average, with excellent prospects for applicants with health care work experience and leadership skills in business and management. Changes in healthcare regulations, implementation of new technologies and emphasis on preventative care contribute to increased need for healthcare management specialists. Services previously provided in hospitals are shifting to offices of health care providers. These smaller offices will require managers with healthcare knowledge and excellent business skills.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Unofficial transcripts for initial admission from all institutions of higher education previously attended (official transcripts required for full admission)
- Complete a graduate application for admission
- Two letters of recommendation
- Essay/Writing Sample
- Resume/C.V.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITES

- Completion of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or equivalent
- Completion of 4 full semester courses (12-16 credits) in Biology, Chemistry, and/or Physics. A General Biology sequence (8 credits) and/or General Chemistry sequence (8 credits) is preferred
