- Completion of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution – all majors welcome

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Cybersecurity Graduate Certificate prepares students for careers in the management of cybersecurity through required courses that align with the CompTIA Security+ certification exam. CompTIA Security+ is a certification that covers best practices in IT security and the essential principals for network security and risk management.

The certificate consists of four courses or 12 total credits that can be completed on-campus or online synchronously through Zoom. The full program can be completed in two semesters.

Course Requirements:

- MIS 588 Business Foundations in Cybersecurity
- MIS 515 Data Communications and Networking
- MIS 590 Intermediate Cybersecurity for Business
- MIS 592 Advanced Cybersecurity for Business

Credits can be applied as electives to the Master of Business Administration program.
