Scope and Content: The Brumback Family Collection contains items, mainly photographs, associated with Private Harrison E. White. A native of New York, White enlisted in the 2nd New York Heavy Artillery on November 1, 1861. He was captured at the 2nd Battle of Bull Run. By the time of the 1870 census White moved to Shenandoah County, Virginia. He worked as a farmer in Shenandoah County until his death in 1913. He is buried in Lebanon Church Cemetery.
