Course Name: NMLB 651: Integrated Midwifery Internship (5 clinical credits)
Dates: May 24, 2021 – August 14, 2021
Scope: Full scope midwifery care: Women's Health, Gyn, Primary Care, Contraception, Triage, Antepartum, Intrapartum, Postpartum, Neonatal
Clinical time requirement: At least 300 hours & numbers of experiences (numbers of experiences supersede number of hours required. Clinical time is adjusted to enable competency attainment.

Your student will have a clinical evaluation tool with them when they arrive at your site, this document can also be found [here](#). The student must turn this completed evaluation form to our office by the end of the fall semester. Often, the student fills out the form as a self-evaluation exercise and then her/his preceptor concurs (or not) with the student's self-evaluation. *The preceptor signature is verification of concurrence.* **Also, please sign the safety statement at the end of the tool.**

Per requirements from the American Commission for Midwifery Education, if you have not yet provided us with documentation, we will need the following:

- Updated license information as well as Number of Years Experience
- Curriculum Vitae or Résumé
- Transcripts or diploma from your midwifery program and, from your graduate program, if different
- Evidence of preceptor training
- ACNM Membership information (if applicable)
- Evidence of AMCB Enrollment
