WINCHESTER CAMPUS

The Winchester Campus is housed in the Health Professions Building located on the Winchester Medical Center campus. The building features 190- and 85-seat multimedia classrooms and new additional classrooms (Fall 2019) plus numerous smaller classrooms for demonstrations, problem-solving exercises, and simulations. Wireless technology provides instant web access throughout the entire building, including the laboratories, conference rooms, library, and fitness area.
